Make some memories! Get the most out of your summer excursion to Escapade at Gillette by enjoying one (or more) of the seven HOPs designed to enhance your Wyoming experience.

Register for a pre-Escapade HOP; arrive early and enjoy full-hookup parking in the Boxelder RV Park on the Escapade grounds at Gillette's Cam-Plex. HOP registration is separate from Escapade registration – you must register for Escapade to be eligible to attend a HOP. **Note: Tour bus contracts require that minimum registration must be met for each tour by May 15, or the tour is subject to cancellation.**

Note: The remaining full-hookup spaces at Escapade are reserved for HOP- goers! Reserve your spot today!

Yellowstone National Park Tour HOP – June 27- 28, 2008

America's first national park—discover it with fellow Escapees. Tour includes transportation, guides, lodging, baggage handling, all meals and snacks on the bus, all entrance fees, taxes, and gratuities.

Devils Tower and Coal Mine Tour HOP – June 26 or 28 or July 5, 2008

This HOP combines two of northeast Wyoming's highlights: Devils Tower National Monument and the Eagle Butte Mine. Devil's Tower is the major portion of this HOP. Tour includes breakfast and lunch.

Presidents and Indians HOP – June 26 or July 5, 2008

Tour Mount Rushmore in the beautiful Black Hills of South Dakota and the Crazy Horse Memorial. On the return trip, you'll stop at the Vore Buffalo Jump. Breakfast included.

Coal Mine Tour HOP – June 26 or 27, 2008

Gillette is known as the energy capital of the nation, due in part to the many coal mines in the area. We'll see how coal is mined from surface mines still containing billions of tons of low-sulfur coal. This is an in-depth coal mine tour. Breakfast included.

Little Big Horn Battlefield Tour HOP – June 28, 2008

First stop is Fort Phil Kearny to set the stage for the famous conflict, then on to the modern trading post near the Custer Battlefield for a picnic lunch and the Little Bighorn National Monument. Tour includes breakfast and lunch.

Sheridan, Wyoming HOP – June 27 or July 5, 2008

In 2006, Sheridan was selected by *True West* magazine as the best Western town in America. You'll also be able to wander Sheridan's historic district, museums, and restaurants. Tour includes breakfast.

Motorcycle HOP –June 27-28, 2008

Join Bud Carr and Bruce Schweichler as they ride their motorcycles through two scenic loop tours in the beautiful Wyoming countryside. This is a two-day HOP with breakfast each day.
