Escapees CARE needs your help!



If you are someone who wants to make a difference, Escapees CARE center needs your help. When you volunteer at CARE you will be rewarded by the participants' smiles and the knowledge that you are making a difference in someone's life. And, when you volunteer for a month or more, you will be rewarded with tangible benefits that will help your pocketbook, too!

CARE needs volunteers for one-two month sessions beginning:

May 1, 2009	4 teams needed
Jun. 1, 2009	3 teams needed
Jul. 1, 2009	4 teams needed
Aug.1, 2009	4 teams needed
Sep.1, 2009	5 teams needed

CARE provides monthly volunteers with:

- ✓ An RV site with full hookups while you work. (You only pay for electric and propane.)
- ✓ Three free meals a day.
- ✓ Use of nice amenities including reading and video libraries, a swimming pool, big screen TV and miles of quiet roads to walk. You will be surrounded by fellow RVers, who like you, believe in the sharing-and-caring principles of the Escapees RV Club.

What does CARE ask of you?

Primary tasks assigned to volunteers are working in the kitchen, driving participants to various appointments, and answering the phone afterhours (in your RV). Depending on the number of teams available, you should be prepared to work four hours a day, six days a week—a minimum of 24 hours per person, per week.

For those of you less familiar with this bountiful program, Escapees CARE (which stands for Continuing Assistance for Retired Escapees) is located in Livingston, Texas, and is part of the 200-acre Rainbow's End/Escapees national headquarters complex. Escapees CARE center is a one-of-a-kind facility built specifically for RVers. CARE's mission is to provide a safe haven with professional assistance at affordable prices for folks whose travels are permanently ended because of age, or temporarily interrupted because of health problems. That's right, some participants may just need a little help while they recuperate from a knee replacement. Others are in dire need of professional help for the things they may no longer be able to do. CARE is not a nursing home. In fact, its goal is to delay or eliminate the need for a nursing home.
