 Registration is valid for the **lifetime** of your animal.

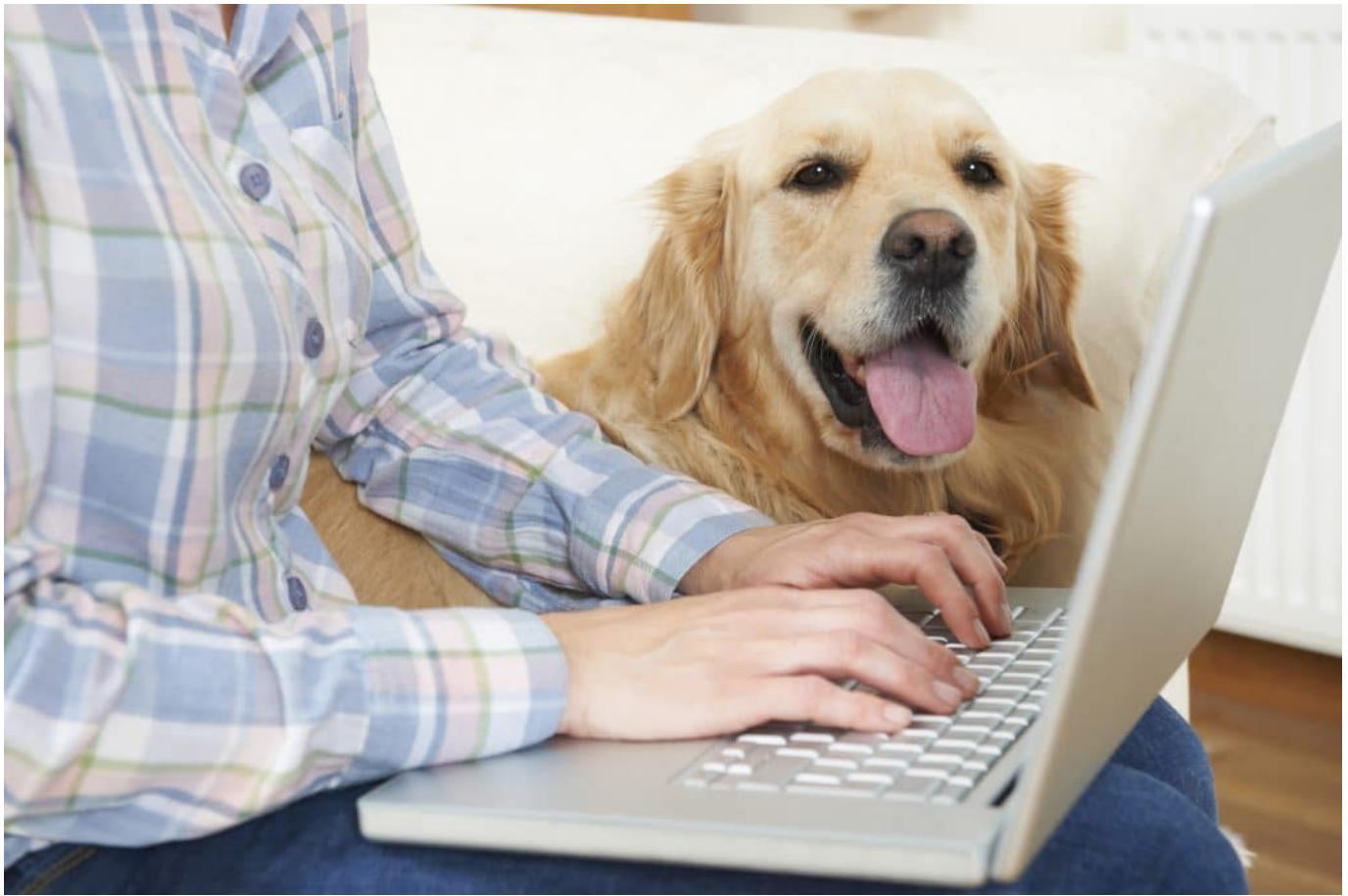
Your **service animal** or **emotional support animal** will be placed in the **official US Service and Support Animal Registry Database**.

Basic Information	<p>Emotional support animals help individuals with emotional disabilities such as anxiety or depression by providing comfort and support. Any animal can be an emotional support animal. Federal law does not require these animals to have any specific training and you do not have to be physically disabled to have an emotional support animal.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The animal should have good social skills if taken in public places. • The animal is allowed in all housing regardless of pet policy, with any pet deposit or pet rent being waived. * • The animal is allowed to fly with you as long as it can fit under your seat. * • * A note from a licensed mental health provider or doctor is frequently required for housing and always for airline travel. Click here to see if you qualify! 	<p>Service animals must be trained to perform a task with a disability or medical condition. The task must be visible. Dogs and miniature horses are the most common service animals. You do not need a note from a doctor for a service animal.</p> <p>Examples of tasks that can be performed by a service animal include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Alerting to sounds • Diabetic alert • Carries your medication for seizures, epilepsy, sclerosis • Assists with pain management • Comforts sufferers of PTSD • Helps autistic people with social functioning <p>Service Animals are allowed anywhere the public is allowed. They are allowed in all housing regardless of pet policy with any pet deposit or pet rent being waived. Service Animals are allowed in the cabin of an airplane for free. * All public access locations are listed on this website.</p>

Need a Doctor's Letter for Airline Travel and Housing?

In order to prove that an animal is an emotional support animal, you may be asked to provide documentation from a licensed professional (doctor, psychiatrist, or other mental health professional) stating that the animal is an essential part of treatment for a disability. A landlord or business may ask you to provide a doctor's note or they could deny you and your emotional support animal. All airlines require a doctor's note.

Regardless of whether you are asked to show a doctor's letter, it is very helpful to have one on file just in case.
